Asia Pacific Disaster Relief

Typhoons. Floods. Landslides. Nearly half of the world's deadly natural disasters occur in the Asia Pacific region, according to the UN.

When disasters strike, those left behind can be left with a deep sense of loss, insecurity, and overwhelming need. Families and individuals in affected areas need immediate assistance, including shelter, food, clean water, and household items. During disasters and emergency situations, NCM partners with local churches as they work to assist people in meeting short-term and long-term needs—both physical and spiritual.
